The funding would be used for an upgraded technology infrastructure project of the regional 9-1-1 center. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Regional 9-1-1 center is responsible for all 911 calls and dispatches emergency responders to 14 local police and fire departments. The project includes necessary upgrades to the PSAPs integrated radio console infrastructure.
