A BILL

To require Transmission Organizations accept bids from aggregators of certain retail customers, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "[_____]".
- 5 SEC. 2. AGGREGATOR BIDDING INTO ORGANIZED POWER
- 6 MARKETS.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any prohibition
- 8 established by a State regulatory authority with respect

- 1 to who may bid into an organized power market, each
- 2 Transmission Organization shall accept any bid from an
- 3 aggregator of retail customers that aggregates the demand
- 4 response of the customers of utilities that distributed more
- 5 than 4 million megawatt-hours in the previous fiscal year.
- 6 (b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 180 days after the
- 7 date of enactment of this section, the Federal Energy Reg-
- 8 ulatory Commission shall issue a rule to carry out the re-
- 9 quirements of subsection (a).
- 10 (c) State Regulatory Authority; Transmission
- 11 Organization.—In this section, the terms "State regu-
- 12 latory authority" and "Transmission Organization" have
- 13 the meanings given such terms in section 3 of the Federal
- 14 Power Act (16 U.S.C. 796).
