3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Responsive Energy De5 mand Unlocks Clean Energy Act" or the "REDUCE
6 Act".

1SEC. 2. AGGREGATOR BIDDING INTO ORGANIZED POWER2MARKETS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any prohibition established by State law or a State commission (as such 4 5 term is defined in section 3(15) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 796(15))) with respect to who may bid into 6 7 an organized wholesale electric market, each Transmission 8 Organization shall, consistent with any applicable market 9 rules that do not establish such prohibition, allow aggregators of retail customers to submit bids that aggre-10 gate demand flexibility of the customers of utilities that 11 12 distributed more than 4 million megawatt-hours in the previous fiscal year. 13

(b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 12 months after
the date of enactment of this section, the Federal Energy
Regulatory Commission shall promulgate a final rule pursuant to subsection (a).
